The Connecticut Department of Transportation (DOT), headquartered in Newington, CT, has an opportunity for a Transportation Public Transit Administrator.

The DOT has an immediate need for a **highly motivated candidate** to assist the Transportation Public Transit Chief in passenger and freight rail services operations, contracts, safety, oversight, regulatory functions, budget, design, construction and maintenance in this complex multi-modal transportation agency.

Successful candidates must demonstrate a knowledge of and ability to apply management principles and techniques to public transit and freight rail operations, contracts, safety, budget, administration, maintenance, regulatory functions and infrastructure improvements; considerable knowledge of relevant state and federal laws, statutes and regulations pertaining to rail operations, contracts, regulatory functions, maintenance and safety; considerable knowledge of governmental budgeting principles and practices; considerable interpersonal skills; considerable oral and written communication skills; considerable ability to formulate and implement policy.

Primary responsibilities will include the oversight and support of operations, contracts, maintenance, safety, budget and engineering and construction-related activities on the Connecticut-owned New Haven line, the New Haven-Hartford-Springfield line, the Shore Line East, Connecticut-owned rail freight lines and the rail freight infrastructure program through a staff of approximately forty-eight (48) positions; coordination and oversight as required with various bureaus, outside agencies and railroad operators, the Federal Railroad Administration and Federal Transit Administration; supports the Chief and Commissioner on rail related matters, including liaison with government agencies and industry groups.

The State of Connecticut offers excellent benefits including Extensive Health and Dental coverage, Disability and Life Insurance, generous Time Off package, Retirement Benefits, Family Leave, DCAP, Deferred Compensation, and education and development programs.

Minimum requirements: Ten (10) years' experience in a large organization with broad authority in recommending, formulating and implementing policy in rail operations. Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been in a major rail or bus transportation program at the supervisory level.

Substitutions allowed:

College training may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen (15) semester hours equaling one-half (1/2) year of experience to a maximum of four (4) years for a Bachelor's degree.

A Master's degree in a closely related field may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.
