**The Connecticut Department of Transportation (DOT), headquartered in Newington, CT, has an opportunity for a Transportation Public Transit Assistant Administrator.** The DOT has an immediate need for a highly **motivated candidate to** assist the Transportation Public Transit Administrator in rail facilities safety, oversight, design, construction and maintenance services in this complex multi-modal transportation agency. Successful candidates must demonstrate a knowledge of and ability to apply management principles and techniques to public transit rail design, construction, maintenance and operations; considerable knowledge of relevant state and federal laws, statutes and regulations pertaining to rail design, construction, maintenance and operations; considerable interpersonal skills; considerable oral and written communication skills. Primary responsibilities will include the intermodal design and construction unit supervising twenty-four (24) employees from design and construction groups; will oversee and support all the engineering and construction-related activities on the New Haven line, New Haven-Hartford-Springfield line, Shore Line East, Connecticut-owned rail freight lines and the rail freight infrastructure program; will be responsible for design and construction of major rail projects as well as the ongoing state of good repair and normal replacement projects; will oversee project management and engineering functions; will require coordination and oversight as required with various bureaus, outside agencies and railroad operators, the Federal Railroad Administration and Federal Transit Administration
