Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: The Developmental Specialist 2 will serve primarily children, adolescents and adults with complex behavioral needs, including autistic spectrum disorders, who live in their own homes in the greater New Haven, Meriden and Middletown area. The Developmental Specialist 2 will be independently responsible for conducting detailed functional analyses, developing behavior plans as well as training families and support staff in how to carry out these plans, and would include the identifying of the need for referrals to other mental health providers as appropriate.

General Experience: A Master's degree in psychology from a program accredited by a regional educational board and three (3) years post master's clinical experience which needs to include one (1) year serving the broad range of intellectually disabled population, preferably including children with autism spectrum disorders.

Substitutions Allowed: A Doctorate degree in psychology from a program accredited by a regional educational board and two (2) years' experience in working with the broad range of developmentally disabled population, including children with autism spectrum disorders.
