Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status in the class may apply for lateral transfer. Those candidates appearing on Re-employment or SEBAC lists must be given first consideration.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Duties consistent with the Developmental Specialist 2 job description. This position will administer psycho-diagnostic tests, interprets test results; writes reports on intellectual functioning; provides individual and group therapy; develops and implements behavioral programs, trains direct care staff in their implementation; prepares case notes/ participates in behavior analysis, data collection and analysis, program development and evaluation, behavioral techniques; participates in clinical and interdisciplinary case conferences and meetings; supervises employees of a lesser grade. Also will provide direct behavioral support for CLA's (Community Living Arrangement's) in Cheshire. Psychological testing requirements for ICF (Intermediate Care Facility). **May serve as a Qualified Intellectual Disabilities Professional (QIDP formerly QMRP) as required by Federal regulations;** perform related duties as required.

General Experience: A Master's degree in community psychology, educational psychology, experimental psychology, psychology or rehabilitative psychology from a program accredited by a regional educational board AND three (3) years of experience in conducting psychological testing, assessment and evaluation including one (1) year in treating and/or working with clients in the appropriate specialty serviced by the agency. For State Employees the experience component shall be interpreted to be at the level of a Developmental Specialist 1.

Substitution Allowed: A Doctorate degree in community psychology, educational psychology, experimental psychology, psychology or rehabilitative psychology from a program accredited by a regional educational board AND two (2) years of experience in treating and/or working with clients in the appropriate speciality serviced by the agency may be substituted for the General Experience.

Special Requirement: Incumbent will be required to travel
