Duties may include but not limited to: Ensures psychiatric nursing standard of care is met by all staff; organizes and compiles nursing audits; direct supervision of nursing staff; participates in divisional decision making and standard/policy setting; works with state agencies/facility departments to ensure there are appropriate staff and appropriate patient/staff ratios; organizes, compiles, writes, and submits necessary reports; monitors and evaluates staff performances and when necessary and address staff disciplinary issues acts as a nursing resource to non-nursing and nursing staff; facilitates TEAM building and management; works with Division Director and other Executive Staff to promote professional growth and change; works with executive CVH staff and divisional staff to promote optimum patient care and safety; member of Nursing Executive Committee; participates in ongoing nursing professional development activities hospital wide; and performs related duties as required.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

General Experience: Three (3) years of experience in hospital nursing in a managerial or supervisory capacity at or above the level of a Supervising Nurse working with the patients/clients serviced by the agency.

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license as a registered professional nurse in Connecticut. Incumbents in this class serving in the capacity of the Nurse Executive are required to possess a master's degree in nursing, social or behavioral science, public health administration, health care administration, hospital administration or a related field.
