Duties may include but not limited to: Ensures psychiatric nursing standards of practice and care are met by all staff; oversees and provides for direct supervision of nursing staff; ensures there is an appropriate mix of nursing personnel and supports patient/staff ratios; meets regulatory requirements and implements plans of correction as appropriate; participates in both discipline (nursing) and divisional decision making structures in the development of standards, policies and programs for patients and staff; conducts and compiles nursing audits; writes, and submits necessary reports; monitors and evaluates staff performances; conducts rounds periodically on 2nd, 3rd shift and weekends; meets with staff on off shifts to address issues, both professional and discipline; acts as a nursing resource to nursing and non-nursing staff; facilitates team building and management; works with the Division Director and other Executive Staff to promote professional growth and change and assure optimum patient care and safety; member of the Nursing Executive Committee; participates in providing ongoing professional development programs and activities for nursing; and represents nursing on hospital committees; and performs related duties as required.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

General Experience: Three (3) years of experience in hospital nursing in a managerial or supervisory capacity at or above the level of a Supervising Nurse working with the patients/clients serviced by the agency.

Special Requirements: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license as a registered professional nurse in Connecticut. Incumbents in this class serving in the capacity of the Nurse Executive are required to possess a master's degree in nursing, social or behavioral science, public health administration, health care administration, hospital administration or a related field.
