Eligibility Requirement: Open to the public. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. Candidates on Reemployment/SEBAC lists will be given first consideration.

Description of Duties: At facilities owned by or under control of Department of Energy and Environmental Protection or on private lands governed by a cooperative agreement , operates heavy equipment , applies pesticides, performs general maintenance tasks including but not limited to mowing lawns, raking, picking up trash, cleaning restrooms, washing vehicles, moving furniture, brushcutting, planting shrubs, transplanting, cutting, pruning, etc.; may operate and make minor repairs of light equipment and vehicles such as trucks, tractors, mowing machinery, power saws, boats and related equipment; may receive training in and assist in performing semi-skilled maintenance and/or construction work including but not limited to rough carpentry, painting, masonry, minor electrical, mechanical or plumbing repairs, etc.; may perform patrol and fire fighting activities; may act as a firefighter; may perform clerical duties of very limited duration; and performs related duties as required.

Special Requirements:

1. Incumbents in this class may perform emergency first aid as needed and may be required to obtain and retain a Standard First Aid Certificate.
2. Incumbents engaged in the operation of heavy equipment shall possess and retain the necessary current licenses, permits and or certifications as required by Federal and State laws and regulations.
3. Incumbents performing skilled trade work may be required to possess and retain appropriate current licenses and or certifications as required by a particular trade and will be required to obtain a Commercial Operator's License and a Commercial Pesticides Application License within six-months from the date of hire.
4. Incumbents in this class must be in good health and must retain sufficient physical strength, stamina, agility, visual and auditory acuity to effectively perform the duties of the class.
5. Incumbents may be exposed to some danger of injury working under varying weather conditions, lifting moderate weights and handling chemical solutions.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Basic interpersonal skills;
- Ability to perform basic maintenance and routine manual, mechanical and/or physical work in trade practices;
- Ability to operate and make minor repairs to small tools and mechanical equipment; ability to follow instructions.

General Experience:

- Previous experience in general landscaping; cleaning; light equipment operation; general equipment maintenance; carpentry, and minor electrical experience.
- Experience working with the public.
- Previous experience working in a team setting.
- Must hold a valid Driver's License.

Special Experience:

- Must be able to obtain Commercial Class B Operators License within six months.
