This will be a special appointment of limited duration, which may be extended depending upon performance, college need and availability of funding.

**Eligibility Requirement:** Master's degree in Manufacturing Engineering Technology together with from two to five years of experience in a related field leading to expertise in Manufacturing.

**Applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifications as stated are encouraged to put in writing precisely how their background and experience have prepared them for the responsibilities of this position. They must also provide appropriate references. Exceptions to the degree requirements may be made for compelling reasons.**

**Responsibilities:** Under the supervision of the Director or Coordinator, the Educational Assistant (Business and Industry Instructor) teaches courses at a Community College in subject areas such as applied computer use, mathematics, blueprint reading and set up and operation of complex machine tools. The Instructor provides both classroom lecture and "hands-on" shop instruction.
