- Experience compiling and analyzing complex population health data, evaluating trends, and providing valid interpretations of results for reports and presentations using statistical software such as SAS, SQL, ArcGIS and Instant Atlas;
- Experience writing technical reports, fact sheets, and other written materials, and giving oral presentations, in order to disseminate epidemiological data in a clear and succinct manner to a wide range of audiences, using programs such as Adobe, Word, and PowerPoint;
- Experience in the protection of identifiable health data.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

Knowledge, Skill and Ability: Considerable knowledge of relevant disease processes which affect humans and animals; considerable knowledge of epidemiological methods; considerable interpersonal skills; considerable oral and written communication skills; considerable statistical skills including familiarity with mainframe and/or personal computer applications and interpretation of data; considerable ability to perform complex epidemiological investigations; considerable ability to carry out all aspects of data collection, analysis and interpretation of epidemiological data independently; some supervisory ability. Considerable knowledge of infectious and/or chronic disease processes.

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING

General Experience: Eight (8) years' experience conducting epidemiological investigations in a responsible technical or professional capacity.

Special Experience: Two (2) years' of the General Experience must have involved conducting the full range of tasks in epidemiologic investigations including interviewing and performing trend analyses at or above the level of Epidemiologist 2.

Substitutions Allowed:

1. College training may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen (15) semester hours equalling one half (1/2) year of experience to a maximum of four (4) years' for a Bachelor's degree.
2. A Master's degree in community medicine, public health or a related health science may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.
3. A Doctorate in a related discipline such as Medicine, Public Health or a behavioral or natural science may be substituted for one additional year of the General Experience.

Special Requirements: 1. Incumbents in this class must be willing to be immunized for communicable diseases as necessary and appropriate. 2. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.
