Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status in the class may apply for lateral transfer. Those candidates appearing on Re-employment or SEBAC lists must be given first consideration.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Duties consistent with the Firefighter job specifications. Providing emergency medical care at the EMT-Intermediate level and providing routine ambulance transportation; provide fire suppression services, rescue, hazardous material incident responses and other emergencies as called for. Duties also include fire prevention activities including fire safety inspections and education activities to facility staff and clients. Perform other related duties as required.

General Experience: Knowledge of fire fighting, fire prevention and crash rescue techniques; knowledge of fire inspection and prevention techniques; knowledge of emergency medical techniques; interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills; ability to evaluate emergency situations and develop effective courses of action; ability to work under pressure; ability to prepare reports Special Requirements.

Special Experience: National certification by the National Board of Fire Service Professional Qualifications (NPQS) or the International Fire Services Accreditation Congress (IFACC) or State Certification by the Connecticut Fire Academy that meet the provisions of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Firefighter 2.

Special Requirements: Must possess and retain a valid Connecticut Class II Motor Vehicle Operator license. Will be required to obtain and maintain Emergency Medical Technician (Intermediate) certification.

Substitution Allowed: Successful completion of prescribed training and probationary requirements set forth in the class of Protective Services Trainee.
