Eligibility Requirement: Candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Duties may include but not limited to: Provide specialized and professional nursing care to adults participating in outpatient and inpatient clinical research studies. Work under the supervision of Supervising Nurse and Program Directors of Connecticut Mental Health Center, and in collaboration with research staff on the Clinical Neuroscience Research Unit (CNRU) at the Connecticut Mental Health Center, and Yale Center for Clinical Investigation (YCCI-HRU). Implement research protocols in accordance with Good Clinical Practice guidelines governing the protection of human subjects and the ethical conduct of research while maintaining compliance with University, State and Federal regulations. Conduct clinical research for the Yale Medical School Department of Psychiatry at the Clinical Neuroscience Research Unit (CNRU). Follow the unique policies and procedures associated with research and clinical care at each site. Document nursing interventions and outcomes appropriately at each unit, including the use of Electronic Medical Records. Ensure compliance with Institutional Review Board approved research protocols by: Monitoring changes in Institutional Review Board policies related to human research and approved protocol amendments. Attending didactic classes presented by the Human Research Protection Program. Perform other related duties as assigned.

General Experience: Two (2) years' experience as a Registered Professional Nurse

Special Experience: One (1) year of the General Experience must have been working with the type of patients and/or clients serviced by the agency.

Substitution Allowed: A Bachelor's degree in Nursing may be substituted for one (1) year of the General Experience

Special Requirement: Must possess and retain a current license as a registered professional nurse in Connecticut. Must possess, retain and carry a valid Connecticut Driver's License. Travel in the community is required.
