Eligibility Requirement:

Candidates must have applied for and passed the IT Analyst 2 exam, and be on a current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services. State employees currently holding the above title, may apply for a lateral transfer. Reemployment/SEBAC candidates will be given first priority. Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.

Required Skills:

Any candidate must possess in-depth C# and object-oriented programming experience, as well as working knowledge in mid-range DB2 (Version 8 and 9) environments. Candidates must be proficient in DB2 SQL from an application standpoint. Candidates must possess actual work experience in Relational Database Management System (RDBMS) design and be able to read ER Diagrams. Candidates must have real job experience in developing Crystal Reports (version 7) from both an end user standpoint and also making calls to Crystal Reports from application code. Candidates must be proficient in the Windows XP operating system environment and navigating Windows networks. Candidates must possess the ability to work independently, as well as communicating effectively with both business users and technical staff, verbally, and in writing.

Preferred Skills:

Working knowledge of ODBC connections would be preferred as well. Experience with large scale enterprise applications deployed using .NET, as well as SQL Server 2008, SQL Reporting Services, Microsoft Visual studio and Report Builder is considered a plus.

General Experience:

Six years of experience in information technology (IT) operations, programming, systems/software development or another IT related support area.

Special Experience:

One year of the General Experience must have been performing professional information technology work in one the following areas: (1) Installation and support of microcomputer hardware, software and operating systems. (2) Analysis, design and development of information systems. (3) Network hardware and software installation and support. (4) Network hardware and/or software problem diagnosis and resolution. Note: For state employees this is interpreted at the level of Information Technology Analyst 1.

Substitutions Allowed:

College training in management information systems, computer science or information technology related area may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen semester hours equaling six months of experience to a maximum of four years for a Bachelor's degree. A Master's degree in management information systems, computer science or electrical engineering may be substituted for one additional year of the General Experience.
