Candidates must have applied for and passed the Information Technology Analyst 2 exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status in the class may apply for a lateral transfer.

Minimum Qualifications:

Considerable knowledge of principles and techniques of systems analysis, design, development and programming; considerable knowledge of principles and theories of business planning; knowledge of methods and procedures used to conduct detailed analysis and design of computer applications; knowledge of project management principles and techniques; knowledge of principles and techniques of business information systems re-engineering; considerable logic and analytical skills; considerable oral and written communication skills; considerable problem solving skills; interpersonal skills; project coordination skills; considerable ability to write, test, and debug computer programs; considerable ability to use programming development tools; considerable ability to prepare manuals, reports, documentation and other written materials; considerable ability to identify, analyze and resolve complex business and technical problems; and ability to analyze and debug complex software programs.

Preferred Experience:

This position will serve on the application development and data base team. Candidates must have strong experience in COBOL and CICS; Experience in using and troubleshooting batch and CIS programs; Experience in VSAM and mapset creations; Experience in designing , developing and interfacing mainframe applications; Experience in Vendor Developed applications; Excellent communication skills and Excellent supervisory skills.
