Eligibility Requirement:

Candidates must have applied for and passed the INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY ANALYST 2 exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.

The Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection is seeking a results-oriented, team player with strong systems analysis, development and project management skills for an IT Analyst 2 position.

The person who serves in this technical position will work closely with various units to automate and/or streamline existing systems, develop new systems that enhance statewide emergency services and achieve significant improvements in agency support staff productivity and efficiency.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Manage multiple information systems projects simultaneously that automate manual processes and reduce/eliminate existing backlogs across the agency's units
- Increase the department's portfolio of online services
- Drive greater collaboration and information sharing amongst federal, state and local partners
- Implement strategic application development, testing and staging environments at HQ data center
- Enhance the performance and value of existing unit databases
- Migrate legacy databases to a more robust and secure platform
- Enhance the agency's IT security and disaster recovery posture
- Work with Agency Data Officer to promote and support State of CT Open Data Initiative
- Migrate department Intranet site to a more strategic and collaborative platform
- Serve as an agency technical contact for all CJIS-related projects, including the CT Information Sharing System (CISS)
- Enhance department information systems to better leverage social media

- Experience with managing large, complex, public safety information systems projects (PMI certification a plus)
- Experience with gathering requirements, developing use cases, test cases and plans
