The University of Connecticut Health Center is prepared to deploy the CHIN platform in a limited production environment during the 2012- 2013 fiscal year. The Connecticut Health Information Network (CHIN) is a federated network that enables the integration and sharing of diverse data maintained by Connecticut State agencies. The IT Project Manager will work to coordinate stakeholders, ensure data security and privacy requirements are met, lead installation/maintenance efforts for servers, network infrastructure and software for CHIN. The IT Project Manager will also dedicate their time to internal systems maintenance and development, quality improvement and new product development.

General Knowledge: Extensive knowledge of hardware/software technologies used within applicable area, particularly open source software, programming languages, database technologies, screen design and navigation, system interfaces, portal technology and system development tools, network and communication protocols; strong project management skills; extensive knowledge of project management principles and practices; excellent leadership and management ability to manage and motivate a diverse group within a matrix reporting relationship through lengthy, complex development effort; considerable interpersonal skills; ability to communicate effectively (oral and written); planning and control skills; negotiation skills and experience; considerable analytical and interpretive skills to evaluate complex business and technical issues and identify innovative solutions; excellent problem solving skills; vendor management experience; excellent customer service skills; supervisory ability; broadly focused and able to manage multiple efforts concurrently.

Preferred Skills and Ability:

- Considerable communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to manage complex projects and maintain relationships with diverse stakeholders.
- Bachelors Degree and 3-5 years experience in IT Project management particularly in application deployments impacting multiple organizations/departments.
