The Workers' Compensation Commission is presently recruiting for an individual to serve as the lead support analyst for the agency's flagship information system WCS (Workers' Compensation System). This system is written in PowerBuilder. Applicants for this position must be able to show: 1) advanced PowerBuilder skills and 2) at least five years experience with this language. WCS is used in the agency's eight district offices to support the core claims and hearings function of this agency, as well as in the Hartford central office to support peripheral functions. The successful applicant will acquire in depth knowledge about the rules and process of workers' compensation in the State of Connecticut, will be able to knowledgably converse with the agency's commissioners, district administrators and other district office staff, and will assume the lead IT role in the agency's Claims Committee (an IT/user committee responsible for establishing the direction of WCS). The ITA 2 reports to the IT manager, and the position is located in the Office of the Chairman in Hartford.
