## **INSTRUCTOR OF MATHEMATICS**

Full-time, 10-Month (Tenure-Track position)

**ANTICIPATED START DATE:** August 25, 2013 (contingent upon funding)

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Master's degree in Mathematics or Mathematics Education required. College-level teaching experience and the ability to teach a full spectrum of courses in Mathematics from developmental through calculus level. Demonstrated ability to engage students as active participants in the teaching/learning process. Experience teaching with graphing calculators or the software simulation of them. Knowledge of learning outcomes assessment. Active participation in professional development activities and familiarity with current trends in mathematics and mathematics education. Demonstrated commitment to the community college mission and its diverse student population. Evidence of strong verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills.

Applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifications noted above may be considered for this position by stating in writing precisely how their experience has prepared them for the responsibilities of this position and by providing appropriate references. Exceptions to the degree requirements may be made for compelling reasons.

**REFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:** Experience teaching both developmental and credit level mathematics courses at a community college. Knowledge of placement and assessment practices in mathematics. Knowledge of current student success initiatives in the discipline. Ability to use instructional technology, experience with online or hybrid courses, and/or use of web-based instructional support systems. Evidence of a reflective teaching practice. Ability to address the needs of a diverse student body with an array of learning styles. Knowledge of placement and assessment practices in mathematics. Potential for long term growth both as a teacher and as a creative and collaborative colleague.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Teach 24 credit hours of Mathematics including both developmental and degree courses. Participate in discipline, department, and college meetings, develop curriculum, participate in program and NEASC reviews and assessment at the course, program and graduation levels. Duties may include K-12 collaboration, community outreach, and other service activities consistent with the mission of the college. Assist with interviewing and evaluating adjunct faculty in Mathematics. Provide academic advising and assist in recruitment and retention of students. Perform additional responsibilities in accordance with an approved plan. Serve on college committees as required.

**MINIMUM SALARY:** \$47,705 approximate annual salary, with full benefits package (salary subject to collective bargaining increases).
