The Connecticut Insurance Department is recruiting for an Insurance Accredited Financial Examiner vacancy in the Field Financial Examination Unit of the Financial Regulation Division.

General Knowledge: Considerable knowledge of accounting and auditing principles and practices; considerable knowledge of the organization and business practices of insurance companies; knowledge of and ability to interpret and apply insurance statutes, regulations and bulletins; considerable interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills; considerable ability to analyze and evaluate insurance company's control environment financial statements and business.

Preferred Skills and Ability: Conduct field examinations of the financial condition of insurance companies; understand and conduct reviews of the key functional activities of insurance companies, identify and assess inherent risk in key activities, identify and evaluate risk mitigation strategies/controls, determine residual risks, conduct detailed examination procedures; verify the valuation and legality of assets, determine the adequacy of liabilities, verify statements and reports; prepare written examination reports. Experience in statutory accounting is a plus.

General Experience: Seven years of experience in one or more of the following areas: regulatory examination of financial condition of insurance companies; accounting, auditing and/or actuarial work in the insurance industry.

Special Experience: One (1) year of the General Experience must have been at or above the professional working level of an insurance examiner/auditor. For State employees that will be interpreted as at or above the level of Insurance Examiner (Examination).

Substitution Allowed: 1. College training in Accounting, Insurance, Business, Finance, Actuarial Science, or Economics may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen (15) semester hours equaling one-half (1/2) year of experience to a maximum of four (4) years for a Bachelor's degree. 2. A Master's degree in Accounting, Insurance, Business or Economics may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience. 3. Certification as a Certified Internal Auditor may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.

Special Requirements: (1) Incumbents **must possess and retain the designation of Accredited Financial Examiner (AFE), or Certified Public Accountant (CPA) certification at the time of appointment.** (2) Position requires 30-40% overnight travel within Connecticut and out-of-state
