Candidates must have applied for and **passed the IT Analyst 2 exam**, and be on a current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services. State employees **currently holding the above title**, may apply for a lateral transfer. **Reemployment/SEBAC candidates will be given first priority.**

**Required Skills:**

**Must possess in-depth experience in reading and coding in the Delphi 5 language, as well as working in mid-range DB2 (Version 8 and 9), as well as extensive DB SQL experience. Candidates must possess actual work experience in Relational Database Management System (RDBMS) design, from an application point of view. Able to read both logical and physical RDBMS designs. Possess real job experience with developing Crystal Reports (version 7), as well as experience calling CR7 from within Delphi 5. Must be proficient in the Windows XP operating system environment and moving around Windows networks. Must possess the ability to work independently with little assistance, as well as communicating effectively with both business users and technical staff, verbally, and in writing.**

**Preferred Skills:**

**Interfacing Delphi 5 to DB2 is a plus, as well as working knowledge of ODBC connections. Experience with large scale enterprise applications deployed using .NET, as well as SQL Server 2008, SQL Reporting Services, Microsoft Visual studio and Report Builder.**

**General Experience:**

Six years of experience in information technology (IT) operations, programming, systems/software development or another IT related support area.

**Special Experience:**

One year of the General Experience must have been performing professional information technology work in one the following areas: (1) Installation and support of microcomputer hardware, software and operating systems. (2) Analysis, design and development of information systems. (3) Network hardware and software installation and support. (4) Network hardware and/or software problem diagnosis and resolution. Note: For state employees this is interpreted at the level of Information Technology Analyst 1.

College training in management information systems, computer science or information technology related area may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen semester hours equaling six months of experience to a maximum of four years for a Bachelor's degree. A Master's degree in management information systems, computer science or electrical engineering may be substituted for one additional year of the General Experience.
