Region 4 - Manchester Area Office is currently recruiting for a one (1) Clinical Social Worker Associate. This position is part of a multi-disciplinary team and is accountable for skilled clinical social work treatment and leadership services involving complex case assignments. This position is full time (37.5 hours) weekly, 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Monday - Friday.

This position is responsible for providing consultation to Area Office staff around children and families with complex psychological and behavioral health issues including substance abuse. It will also entail review of clinical evaluations and assessments provided by various evaluators and treatment providers. Candidates must have knowledge of and preferably direct experience in providing evidence based treatment modalities and best practices, group home and residential programming, and in community based services. Ideal candidates will also have a strengths-based approach to assessment and treatment and will also have strong skills for provider relations, including problem solving, and communication both (verbal and written). They will also work in partnership with multiple community and State partners.

General Experience: one (1) year of experience as a licensed clinical social worker.

Special Experience: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Incumbents in this class may be required to have ability in Spanish oral and written communication in designated positions. Incumbent in this class may be required to travel.
