Eligibility Requirement: The candidate chosen for this position must have skills and knowledge in building and equipment maintenance; Knowledge of Plumbing/fuel systems; knowledge of maintenance problems and their proper handling; must possess interpersonal skills, oral and written communication skills and the ability to follow written and oral instruction.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Considerable knowledge of methods, tools, equipment, materials and procedures of specific trade or work area; some knowledge of maintenance problems and their proper handling; skill in manual and machine operations of trade; some interpersonal skills; some oral and written communication skills; ability to follow written and oral instruction.

General Experience: Two (2) years experience in one of the skilled trades.

Substitution Allowed: Graduation from a vocational or technical school with a diploma designating completion of subject requirements in a maintenance trade area may be substituted for the General Experience.

Special Requirement: Candidates must be able to pass a military security clearance.

Physical Requirement: Incumbents in this class must have adequate physical strength, stamina, physical agility and visual auditory acuity and must maintain such physical fitness as to be able to perform the duties. A physical examination may be required.

Working Conditions: Incumbents in this class may be required to lift moderate to heavy weights and may be exposed to significant levels of dust, heat, noise, extreme weather conditions and risk of injury from equipment.
