Eligibility Requirement:

Candidates must have applied for and **passed the IT Analyst 2 exam**, and be on a current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services. State employees **currently holding the above title**, may apply for a lateral transfer. **Reemployment/SEBAC candidates will be given first priority.**

Required Skills:

Proficient in programming in COBOL, Command Level CICS, BMS, DB2, JCL and Utilities (i.e. IDCAMS, SyncSort, IEFBR14, compile and links, etc), VSAM, Online and Batch Expediter, CEDF, able to resolve abends using batch and online Abendaid, familiar with using ISPF including MAI, IOF, Dispatch, and all other commonly used dialog screens. Ability to work with data using various Syncsort and other utilities and performing data analysis is required. Extensive experience working with users to learn new applications. Demonstrated ability to work independently. Demonstrated enthusiasm shown by taking initiative to pursue resolution of problems in a timely manner. Able to prepare detailed system documentation, with little or no assistance.

Preferred Skills:

Experience with Motor Vehicle applications, especially Connecticut DMV will be given priority. Programming expertise and experience using the Assembler and Dylakor (Vision report) languages will be given priority as well.

General Experience:

Six years of experience in information technology (IT) operations, programming, systems/software development or another IT related support area.

Special Experience:

One year of the General Experience must have been performing professional information technology work in one the following areas: (1) Installation and support of microcomputer hardware, software and operating systems. (2) Analysis, design and development of information systems. (3) Network hardware and software installation and support. (4) Network hardware and/or software problem diagnosis and resolution. Note: For state employees this is interpreted at the level of Information Technology Analyst 1.

Substitutions Allowed:

College training in management information systems, computer science or information technology related area may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen semester hours equaling six months of experience to a maximum of four years for a Bachelor's degree. A Master's degree in management information systems, computer science or electrical engineering may be substituted for one additional year of the General Experience.
