Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

Duties include: Provides skilled clinical treatment to a caseload of young adults with mental health needs; coordinates care for 20-25 consumers; prepares recovery plans inclusive of mental health, housing, educational, psychiatric, substance abuse and other needs in collaboration with clients and their families; completes psychosocial evaluations and assessments; conducts therapy sessions weekly at a minimum; participates in clinical meetings and works closely with families and treatment teams to ensure quality of care and positive outcomes for clients and families; communicates with outside providers and referral sources; performs risk assessments; utilizes engagement strategies to increase family involvement; performs related duties as required.

General Experience and Training: Licensure as a marital and family therapist in the State of Connecticut.

Special Requirements: **1)** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice marital and family therapist work pursuant to Sec. 20-195(a-f) of the Connecticut General Statutes. **2)** Incumbents in this class may be required to have knowledge of sign language and communication ability with the deaf and hearing impaired in certain designated positions. **3)** Incumbents in this class may be required to have ability in Spanish oral and written communication in certain designated positions. **4)** Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.
