Duties may include but not limited to: Function as a member of an interdisciplinary treatment team providing a variety of intensive clinical and case management services to adults with a history of severe mental illness and co-occurring disorders; responsible for clinical assessment, individual and/or family counseling, medication monitoring and management, community outreach, crisis prevention and intervention, development of professional relationships with community providers including medical providers; provide nursing assessment and coverage to the outpatient department of CRMHC including providing direct nursing care, responding to on site medical emergencies, coverage of medication clinics, providing consultation to team on complex medical problems of team clients; perform other related duties as assigned.

General Experience: Four (4) years of experience as a professional nurse.

Special Experience: Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been in a psychiatric setting in supervised individual, group and/or family therapy.

Substitution Allowed: A Bachelor's degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) year of General Experience. Master's degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.

Special Requirement: Must possess and retain a current license as a registered professional nurse in Connecticut. Must possess, retain and carry a valid Connecticut Driver's License. Travel in the community is required. Incumbents in this class who write medications must have a current license as an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse issued by the Department of Health.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.
