This position is primarily responsible for planning and administering occupational therapy programs for training persons with mental illness and Acquired Brain Injuries; administer individual and group instruction including various occupational therapies such as activities of daily living, independent living skills, sensorimotor skills and performance assessments; work with the outpatient statewide service ABI unit to evaluate and transition clients from institutional settings to community placements.
