The Department of Children and Families currently has a vacancy for a part-time (24 hours weekly) Principal Psychiatrist at the Albert J. Solnit Children's Psychiatric Center North Campus in East Windsor, CT (formerly Connecticut Children's Place). Schedule is first-shift, 3 to 4 days per week. This position will provide clinical administrative/supervisory functions and/or direct care psychiatric services as a board certified advanced clinician. Experience and Training:

Incumbents in this class must possess and retain certification as a specialist in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or board certification in Adult or Child and Adolescent Psychiatry. Incumbents in this class must also possess and retain a license to practice medicine and surgery in Connecticut. A temporary license may be granted for a period not to exceed one (1) year. Must possess and maintain eligibility for participation in federal health care programs as defined in 42 U.S. 1320a-7b(f).

Note: The filling of this position shall be in keeping with established reemployment, transfer, promotion, and SEBAC employment obligations.
