ELIGIBILITY Candidates must be on the Department of Administrative Services' current certification list for the Environmental Analyst 1 job classification and or have attained permanent status in the class.

DUTIES The Environmental Analyst 1 will participate in the technical review, analysis, communication, and decision making of environmental program data and issues related to Federal Superfund, RCRA corrective action sites and other contaminated sites to ensure the thorough and timely cleanup of contamination in the state of Connecticut. Duties will include assisting with:

- technical review and/or oversight of the investigation and remediation of contaminated sites;
- coordination with current and prospective owners/developers regarding processing specific sites;
- evaluation of work conducted at contaminated sites to ensure compliance with applicable environmental statutes, regulations and guidance;
- investigation, collection of data, and assessment of site conditions;
- research, collection and analysis of data related to soil, groundwater and surface water conditions and contamination, property ownership, financial matters, and other site conditions;
- preparation of environmental assessment reports, work plans, enforcement documents, orders, correspondence, factsheets, forms, and spreadsheets;;
- communicating with the regulated community, local, state, and federal officials, consultants, attorneys, and the general public;
- and participation in public meetings and providing testimony at public hearings and court proceedings.

PREFERRED CRITERIA The preferred candidate will have:

- Ability to interpret and utilize hydrology and hydrologic studies, soil surveys, aerial photos, topographic and other resource maps, technical charts, graphs, data tables, engineered site development and construction drawings and plans;
- Ability to use software and applications designed for fate and transport modeling, statistical analysis, GIS and database management, including ArcView, ArcInfo, and MS Access;
- Ability to write technical reports and environmental impact statements.
- Excellent organizational and research skills, including the ability to organize, track and prioritize multiple projects; and
- Successful experience leading or participating in a team project.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS The incumbent will be required to have and maintain a valid driver's license and to travel within the state.

WORK CONDITIONS The duties require work in year-round weather conditions and in uncomfortable positions, and the incumbent may be subject to injury or personal harm from environmental and physical conditions.
