The SHENIPSIT STATE PARK UNIT consists of Shenipsit and Nipmuck State Forests and Bigelow Hollow State Park. The unit has flood control dams, 4 boat launches, several wildlife management areas, a swimming area, recreation fields, a field trial area, a picnic pavilion, restroom facilities, and composting toilets.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES This EP Maintainer 2 will be responsible for independently performing the full range of maintenance and moderately skilled trade tasks in areas such as carpentry, painting, electrical, plumbing, masonry, road maintenance, landscaping, mechanical repairs, etc. Duties may include maintenance and moderately skilled maintenance work on buildings and equipment including, but not limited to, simple automotive repairs and light equipment repairs; sharpens saws and axes; performs simple plumbing tasks such as a union change or faucet repairs, rough carpentry, painting, minor electrical repairs, etc.; operates and maintains trucks, tractors, boats and related equipment; uses and maintains firefighting equipment; may lead a small seasonal crew or group of fire fighters; may do planting, transplanting, cutting and pruning; may perform tasks relating to care, propagation and stocking of fish including maintenance and repair of hatchery and stocking equipment; may work with blueprints and specifications; may work with support services in areas of general maintenance of lands, buildings and dams; may perform patrol and fire fighting activities; may act as a firefighter; may perform clerical duties of very limited duration; may perform emergency first aid as needed; and related duties as required.

WORKING CONDITIONS The EP Maintainer 2 will be exposed to year-round weather conditions, will be required to work in uncomfortable conditions, and may be exposed to some danger of injury while working under varying weather conditions, lifting moderate weights, handling chemical solutions, operating various types of equipment and vehicles, and other job-related tasks; and may be required to work weekends and/or holidays. EP Maintainers may be required to change locations statewide due to the required biennial shift and location bidding process.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

General Experience Must have experience and training which would provide the skills and abilities to perform the duties above.

Must also have good, basic interpersonal skills; the ability to perform basic maintenance and routine manual, mechanical and/or physical work in trade practices; the ability to operate and make minor repairs to small tools and mechanical equipment, as well as the ability to follow instructions and to use computer software.

Physical Requirements Must be in good health and must have and retain sufficient physical strength, stamina, agility, visual and auditory acuity to effectively perform the duties of the job.

Special Requirements Must have and maintain a current driver license and may be required to acquire, within six months of notification, and maintain: a Class A Commercial Driver License (CDL); Standard First Aid and CPR certificates; licenses and/or certifications as required by Federal and State laws and regulations for the operation of heavy equipment; and/or appropriate current licenses and/or certifications as required by a particular trade.

PREFERRED CRITERIA The preferred candidate will have good interpersonal skills and the ability to work well with the public; experience with plumbing, electrical and carpentry work; experience with small engine, equipment, and vehicle repair and maintenance; operation of equipment including snow plowing and large tractors; and experience leading work crews.
