**Duties may include but not limited to:** Participation on multidisciplinary Competence to Stand Trial (CST) teams or individual evaluations; completion of forensic evaluations of clients who may be in hospitals, correctional facilities and/or at one of three Offices of Forensic Evaluations (Norwich, Hartford-Newington and Bridgeport); extensive writing legal/psychiatric reports; testifying in court regarding forensic matters; participation on examination teams; performs independent examinations during the first shift, preferably in the morning from 8am to 1pm.

**Knowledge, Skill and Ability:**

Knowledge of principles and practices of medicine with particular reference to diagnosis and treatment of clients; knowledge of recent developments in field of psychiatric medicine; considerable interpersonal skills; considerable oral and written communication skills; skill in mental and physical diagnosis; some supervisory ability.

**General Experience:**

Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain a license to practice medicine and surgery issued by the Connecticut Department of Public Health and Addiction Services in accordance with the applicable Connecticut General Statutes. A temporary license may be granted for a period not to exceed one (1) year;

Incumbents in this class must have completed at least one (1) year of residency program experience in psychiatry approved by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME.)

**Special Requirement:**

Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain eligibility for participation in federal health care programs as defined in 42 U.S. § 1320a-7b(f).

**Condition of Appointment:** No permanent State Employee may work in a per diem position.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
