Duties may include but not limited to: Maintain the requirements of our regulatory compliance with the Joint Commission, NFPA, and the Board of Health. This position is responsible for the weekly churn test on two fire pumps, quarterly, semiannual and annual sprinkler tests. Daily readings and adjustments for our hot water, cooling and cold pressure tanks are all required to be performed twice a day. Trace out and repair broken lines using the original as-built blue prints; makes adjustments via computer system for building temp. control; accompany and assist sprinkler vendor for quarterly, semi-annual and annual inspection and tests; check and maintain 2 steam absorption chillers including their vacuum pumps and steam controls; maintain and repair the CMHC steam reducing station from high to low pressure output; maintain and repair CMHC and Lab area Natural Gas system; maintain and repair CMHC pneumatic control and vacuum systems; maintain and repair a needed the CMHC two sewer ejection systems; layout, purchase, and install plumbing for new construction projects; incorporate new construction projects into existing as built drawings; order material and maintain inventory for the centers plumbing shop; maintain and rebuild plumbing fixtures.

General Experience: Four (4) years of experience in plumbing and heating.

Special Experience: Two (2) years of the general experience as a P-1 and/or S-1 license holder performing skilled trade functions.

Substitutions Allowed: 1. Graduation from a vocational or technical school with a diploma designating completion of subject requirements in a maintenance trade area may be substituted for two (2) years of the general experience. 2. Two (2) years of experience as a Qualified Craft Worker Intern may be substituted for the General and Special Experience.

Special Requirements: Must Have a P-1(plumbing) and/or S-1 (heating) licenses (P-2 and S-1 may be considered). Incumbents in this class will be required to retain an unlimited contractor's license (P-1, S-1). Incumbents in this class must have adequate physical strength, stamina, physical agility and visual and auditory acuity and must maintain such physical fitness as to be able to perform the duties. A physical examination is required. Incumbents will be required to lift moderate to heavy weight and may be exposed to extreme weather conditions and to risk of injury from equipment. Incumbents in this class may be required to possess and retain specific education and/or experience to meet various certification requirements. Must possess and retain a current motor vehicle operator's license. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.

To be considered for this position:

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: Mental Health Assistant 1 applying to a Mental Health Assistant 1 posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed
2. **DMHAS employees who are promotional or demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
3. **All other applicants** must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
