**General Experience:** Licensure as a Clinical Social Worker in the State of Connecticut

**Special Requirements:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-195 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Must possess and retain a current/valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License. May be required to travel.

**Duties may include but not limited to:** The Crisis Clinician is assigned to the Mobile Crisis Team. Duties include, but are not limited to: Conducting crisis assessments, both on-site and in the field at a variety of community locations. Attend to the safety of clients and staff in all MCT interventions. Respond to crisis telephone calls. Participate in the development of high-risk intervention plans. Participate in team problem-solving. Participate in the development of MCT treatment plans with staff, clients and available collateral individuals. Implement an individualized MCT treatment plan. Conduct follow-up monitoring of the client through In reach or field visits to assess level of stability and degree of participation in the treatment plan. Provide supportive counseling as needed to clients and family. Under supervision, perform toxicology screens both at RVS and in the field.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.

**Eligibility Requirement:** State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

2. **DMHAS employees who are promotion/demotion candidates** must submit pages 1-7 of the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
3. **All Other Candidates:** Individuals must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application. The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
