Duties may include but not limited to: Assists the Supervising Clinician in coordinating the work of the Mobile Crisis Team; Provides clinical risk assessments and develop and implement interventions to manage risk in least restrictive setting. Assists in determining goals, objectives and priorities, including high risk intervention plans. Develops and fosters relationships with and assists in the role of liaison to other operating units within the Agency; Monitors the quality of client care to determine effectiveness and necessity for continued crisis supportive services; Assists in the selection, training, and development of staff. May provide individual and family psychotherapy. Participates in clinical consultations. Promotes and fosters collaborative relationships with community providers. Serve as the On-Call Administrator for the Community Acute Services Program.

General Experience and Training: One year of experience as a licensed clinical social worker.

Special Experience and Training: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice clinical social work pursuant to Sec. 20-105 (m) through (r) of the Connecticut General Statutes. Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a valid driver's license and may be required to travel.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status or candidates who possess the general and special experience and training may apply.

Note: Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.

Application Instructions: Due to the large number of lateral transfer forms and applications received, it is extremely important to note the Position Number (found on the posting) on the DMHAS Lateral Transfer Request Form (upper right-hand corner) and at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application for Examination or Employment (CT-HR-12)

To be considered for this position:

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: CSWA applying to a CSWA posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed.
2. **DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
3. **All other applicants** must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
