Duties may include but not limited to: Serves as the Team Leader for the Community Support Team A. Oversees the daily operations of the Team composed of 7 CSP/RP staff, 8 outpatient clinicians, 2 psychiatrists and a Vocational rehabilitation counselor. Conducts daily team meetings to coordinate the delivery of recovery oriented services with the new Community Support Model and coordinates the care of up to 175 individuals with severe and persistent mental disorders. Oversees the Master Treatment and Recovery Planning process, coordinates training and competency in completion of Functional Assessments, encounter note/documentation requirements, supervises psycho-social rehab groups and coordinates risk assessment(s) and crisis management activities for Team clients. Collaborates with the Team Psychiatrist to address immediate and ongoing client needs. Ensures the implementation of Recovery oriented services, assigns work, conducts group and individual supervision meetings, and provides direct clinical services. Responsible for continued education and supervision of the required psycho-social rehab work completed as depicted in DMHAS fidelity review(s). Ensures that Team services meet DMHAS, RVS, TJC and Medicare/Medicaid standards for timeliness and quality. Participates as a member of the RVS Professional Staff. Participates in RVS Committees. Will be responsible to have on-call responsibilities as deemed necessary, coverage for evening and weekend assignments if clinically depicted/needed.

Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

General Experience: Seven (7) years of professional health care experience in a psychiatric setting.

Special Experience: Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been at a lead level responsible for coordinating the work of a unit or team of professionals in a psychiatric setting.

College training may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen (15) semester hours equaling one-half (1/2) year of experience to a maximum of four (4) years for a Bachelor's degree.

A Master's Degree in a health care field related to one of the disciplines in the Special Experience may be substituted (1) additional year of the General Experience.

Special Experience:

Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a current license as a Clinical Social Worker, a licensed Marital and Family Therapist, a licensed Professional Counselor, or as a Registered Professional Nurse in the State of Connecticut

Note: For State Employees the lead level is interpreted at the level of a Clinical Social Worker Associate for social work discipline, Head Nurse for the nursing discipline, an Associate Professional Counselor and an Associate Marriage and Family Therapist.

Working Conditions: Incumbents in this class may be required to lift and restrain clients, may have significant exposure to communicable and/or infectious diseases and risk of injury and may be exposed to strongly disagreeable conditions.
