UConn Health seeks to fill a temporary/part-time Registered Dietitian position to assist with community based projects in Nutrition Education and Nutrition Interventions and Research. This position requires the special skills associated with Registered Dietitians (RDs) or Dietetic Technicians Registered (DTRs). Community-based Registered Dietitians may be called upon to plan, coordinate, implement and evaluate Community Based Education Programs and web-based/social media support for these programs. This is a temporary part-time position.

Special Requirement: Incumbent must have a Bachelor's degree in nutrition, dietetics, health promotion, health education, a health profession or a related field, plus registration as a Registered Dietitian (RD) or Dietetic Technician Registered (DTR) with the Commission on Dietetic Registration. In addition, the candidate must have at least one of the following:

- Experience delivering programs in an urban, multi-cultural setting
- Experience creating community based educational programming for low income audiences
- Experience conducting interviews and activities with individuals associated with research projects and surveillance projects.

Must have reliable transportation, a valid CT driver's license, have the willingness and ability to travel throughout the state to set up and deliver programming, use electronic composition, tracking, and scheduling tools such as Microsoft Office, and prepare written materials for the intended audience.

Special Experience: This position requires the special skills associated with Registered Dietitians (RDs) Dietetic Technicians Registered (DTRs).

Preferred Requirement: Candidates with bilingual skills. Experience developing print and electronic communications and/or video production. Experience with the Food Processor, a blogging platform, Mail Chimp for eNewsletters, Hoote Suite or other similar software.

Examples of Duties:

Coordinates/implements and delivers educational programs; develops/maintains teaching materials and aids; provides technical support to others in the development of health education materials; serves as educational consultant and resource person to medical and other students, community agencies and allied/affiliated institutions; serves as a consultant in areas of educational methodology; conducts train-the-trainer sessions; performs medical nutrition therapy; conducts research activities such as interviewing study participants, conducting dietary recall; enters data into database or other software; analyzes data; conducts community surveillance activities; assists with writing and preparing articles, blogs and videos for use with web-based and social media applications; meet program report requirements as directed by Federal, State, and University guidelines; performs related duties as required.
