Duties may include but not limited to: Designs, implements and monitors therapeutic treatment programs to serve the needs of patients; provides direct care services to patients using individual and group process; participates as a Rehabilitation Representative on the Treatment Team to guarantee integrated and holistic treatment services; documents services as appropriate to division's /rehabilitation services discipline's standards to ensure quality patient care; provides supervision and/or training of staff, students, volunteers and patients or a Service area to ensure desired patient outcomes; demonstrates commitment to meeting the CVH mission through providing services which reflect shared values, specific competencies and integrated service structures; other related duties as assigned.

Eligibility Requirement: Candidates must have applied for and passed the Rehabilitation Therapist 1 exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. **Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.**

General Experience: Four (4) years of professional experience in the appropriate professional rehabilitation therapy program specialty performing such activities as program evaluation, planning and application for persons with mental, emotional and physical disabilities.

Substitution Allowed: College training in the appropriate recognized therapeutic discipline indicated by the parenthetical title may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen (15) semester hours equaling one-half (1/2) year of experience to a maximum of four (4) years for a Bachelor's degree.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class may be required to possess and maintain a certificate as a Water Safety Instructor (W.S.I.), and/or life saving (CPR, First Aid) from the American Red Cross. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.

Working Conditions: Incumbents in this class may be exposed to some danger of injury and to moderately disagreeable job conditions while providing treatment to persons with disabilities.
