Example of Duties: The Clinical Program Manager's responsibilities include, but are not limited to: overseeing the clinical and administrative functioning of assigned units/programs; chairing unit/program leadership meetings; supervising clinical and rehabilitation supervisors and staff as assigned; directing program planning and evaluation; ensuring collaboration between units/programs and the facility at large; monitoring the effectiveness of the therapeutic milieu; representing unit/program interests to the management and administrative teams; reviewing/approving performance appraisals for program staff; providing consultation and training throughout the facility; representing the facility at external meetings and case consultation conferences; ensuring that clinical work within the units/program is reflective of best practice standards; developing and implementing an annual quality improvement plan for assigned areas; providing clinical services to youth and families when needed.

General Experience: four (4) years of professional experience in behavioral health required as well as a masters degree and license in a clinical discipline.

Special Experience: two (2) years of the general experience must have been supervising professional staff in the delivery of services for children and adolescents.
