Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to: teaches an education curriculum as aligned with State Frameworks, develops lesson plans to align with the curriculum, Assesses and evaluates student performance, establishes criteria for evaluation and maintains records of student performance, understands knowledge of student's background to facilitate classroom planning, participates in planning and placement team meetings as necessary, participates in case review conferences to assess student behavior as necessary, Promotes proper care of instructional materials and equipment, use of classroom behavioral management skills as necessary and any additional assignment as needed in conjunction with School Principal.
