**Duties may include but not limited to:** Serves as the Team Leader for the Lower County Clinical Team. Oversees the daily operations of the Team composed of 3 CSP/RP staff, 1.5 outpatient clinicians, part time psychiatrist, a part time vocational rehabilitation counselor and an office assistant. Conducts daily Team meetings to coordinate the delivery of recovery oriented services with the new Community Support Model and coordinates the care of up to 80 individuals with severe and persistent mental disorders. Oversees the Master Treatment and Recovery Planning process and coordinates risk assessment and crisis management activities for Team clients. Collaborates with the Team Psychiatrist to address immediate and ongoing client needs. Ensures the implementation of Recovery oriented services, assigns work, conducts group and individual supervision meetings, provides direct clinical services. Ensures that Team services meet DMHAS, RVS, TJC and Medicare/Medicaid standards for timeliness and quality. Participates as a member of the RVS Professional Staff. Participates in RVS Committees.

**Eligibility Requirement:** State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.

**General Experience:** Seven (7) years of professional health care experience in a psychiatric setting.

**Special Experience:** Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been at a lead level responsible for coordinating the work of a unit or team of professionals in a psychiatric setting.

**Note:** For State Employees the lead level is interpreted at the level of a Clinical Social Worker Associate for social work discipline, Head Nurse for the nursing discipline, an Associate Professional Counselor and an Associate Marriage and Family Therapist.

**Special Requirement:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a current license as a Clinical Social Worker, a licensed Marital and Family Therapist, a licensed Professional Counselor, or as a Registered Professional Nurse in the State of Connecticut; Incumbents must possess and retain a current motor vehicle operator's license; may be required to travel.

**Working Conditions:** Incumbents in this class may be required to lift and restrain clients, may have significant exposure to communicable and/or infectious diseases and risk of injury and may be exposed to strongly disagreeable conditions.
