Description of Duties: Duties are consistent with the Supervising Nurse job specification. Incumbents in this class at the Department of Veterans' Affairs act a shift supervisor for the facility. Incumbents in this class act as coordinator of nursing services for twenty-four hour coverage in such areas as healthcare and residential services. When assigned to shifts covering weekends, evenings, nights and holidays, incumbents may be responsible for a larger number of patients/veterans, units and staff. Incumbents may be responsible for overseeing all nursing functions in the absence of a Director of Nursing.

General Experience: Four (4) years of experience as a registered professional nurse in a hospital, regional, institutional or psychiatric setting.

Special Experience: Two (2) years of the General Experience must have been at the level of a Clinical Nurse 2, Head Nurse, Head Nurse (Correctional Facility), Forensic Head Nurse or Clinical Nurse coordinator working with the type of patients/clients serviced by the agency.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license as a registered nurse in Connecticut.

Substitutions Allowed: A Bachelor's Degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) year of the General Experience. A Master's Degree in nursing may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules.

State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer.
