Eligibility Requirement: State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status in the class may apply for lateral transfer. Those candidates appearing on Re-employment or SEBAC lists must be given first consideration.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Duties consistent with the Supervising Psychologist 2 (Clinical) job classification the position functions as the Director Clinical Services for the West Region. This position provide clinical oversight and supervision of regional master level psychology staff and Behavior Modification Program Specialists staff; oversees and coordinates UMass referrals and Woodbridge referrals; provides training and evaluation of professional and para-professional staff. Consults with hospital emergency rooms and in patient services for DDS consumers. Consults and develops program plans with other state agencies such as DOC, DHMAS, and DCF due to consumers having multiple agency involvement. Has oversight of the Regional Forensic consumers, evaluation, residential placement reviews for individuals with Intellectual Disabilities and at risk behavioral to reoffend. Completes community competency to stand trial evaluations as mandated by Connecticut state statue. Participates in both probate and criminal cases for transition into or re-entry back to the DDS system. Serves as the DDS clinical representative to the DHMAS/PSRB and correctional systems on clinical and service responsibilities specific to DDS upon consumer release. Provides court testimony in competency hearings and coordinates services with DHMAS court clinics. Other related duties as required.

General Experience: A Doctorate degree in Clinical or Counseling Psychology and three (3) years of post doctoral experience as a licensed clinical psychologist.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a license to practice psychology in Connecticut. Any person employed by the State of Connecticut prior to July 1, 1985 with a title in the psychology series of the classified service shall be exempt from the above licensure requirements pursuant to Public Act 613, Section 119 (c). For certain positions, the appointing authority may require State licensure. Incumbents in this class may be required to be fluent in a foreign language or proficient in the use of the American Sign Language. Valid Connecticut driver's license will be required to travel.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
