Position Description: The Bureau of Engineering and Construction currently has Transportation Engineer 2 (Engineering) position opportunities in the Office of Engineering, State Design, Highway Design Section in Newington. These positions may be underfilled at the level of Transportation Engineer 1 (Engineering) or Transportation Engineer Trainee.

These positions will be responsible for the preparation and review of plans and estimates for construction or maintenance of bridges, structures, highways and transportation facilities; performing design for horizontal and vertical geometry necessary for development of highway design plans, profiles and cross sections; develop necessary coordinate geometry for layout of design plans; preparation and review of computation of storm drainage systems and culvert design; performing traffic engineering studies and investigations and preparation and review of traffic engineering plans, specification, and estimates; assisting in project budget preparation, report writing, general planning and administration of unit work from an engineering project coordination and technical standpoint; conducting engineering procedural studies; preparing research and administrative reports; performing related duties as required.

Preferred Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Considerable skill in use of computer aided design and drafting (CADD) applications; considerable technical skills in preparation of engineering and administrative reports; interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills; ability to perform complex mathematical calculations; ability to develop and interpret plans and specifications.

Eligibility: **Candidates for Transportation Engineer 1 (E) or Transportation Engineer 2 (E) must have applied for and passed the Transportation Engineer 1 (Engineering) or Transportation Engineer 2 (Engineering) exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. In order to be considered for Transportation Engineer Trainee, candidates must meet the minimum qualifications for the Transportation Engineer Trainee classification stated on the job specification.
