The Connecticut Department of Transportation currently has several Transportation Engineer 2 (Construction Engineering) or "(CE)" position opportunities in the Bureau of Engineering and Construction, within their Survey Units. These positions may be filled by lateral transfer, promotion or underfilled at the level of Transportation Engineer 1 (CE) or Transportation Engineer Trainee.

The Transportation Engineer Trainee training program is a two-year training program. Upon successful completion of the training program, the incumbents will be promoted to the target classification of Transportation Engineer 1 (CE). After successful completion of one year as a Transportation Engineer 1 (CE), the incumbents will be promoted to Transportation Engineer 2 (CE). These positions are in the P-4 bargaining unit.

The results of this interview process may be used to fill future Transportation Engineer 2 (CE), Transportation Engineer 1 (CE) or Transportation Engineer Trainee positions that become available at various locations for a period not to exceed one (1) year from the closing date of this posting.

Eligibility Requirements:

Candidates must have passed the Transportation Engineer 2 (CE) examination and be on the current examination list as of the closing date of this posting. State employees currently holding the title of Transportation Engineer 2 (CE) or current employees who have attained permanent status in the class may apply for lateral transfer. Candidates who meet the minimum qualifications for the Transportation Engineer Trainee classification stated on the job specification. Transportation Engineer 1 (Construction Engineering) and Transportation Engineer 2 (Construction Engineering) candidates must be on a current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for the applicable classification. DOT employees currently holding one of the above titles may apply for lateral transfer. DOT employees who are interested in these opportunities must apply to this posting in order to be considered.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Considerable knowledge of principles and practices of more than one specialized field in transportation construction engineering in surveys; skill and ability to analyze and evaluate construction location problems and provide effective solutions.

General Experience: CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING: A Bachelor's degree in Engineering or Construction Management and two (2) years of experience in transportation construction engineering.

Special Experience: CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING: One (1) year of the General Experience must have been at the junior working level in a professional transportation construction engineering capacity. For state employees this is interpreted at the level of Transportation Engineer 1 (CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING).

Substitutions allowed:

*Possession of Land Surveyor (LS) licensure or Professional Engineer (PE) licensure from the Department of Consumer Protection State Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors consistent with C.G.S. §20-302 may be substituted for the Bachelor's degree requirement.

*Possession of Land Surveyor-In-Training (LSIT) licensure or Engineer-In-Training (EIT) licensure from the Department of Consumer Protection State Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors consistent with C.G.S. §20-302 may be substituted for the Bachelor's degree requirement.

*Possession of at least Level III certification in the Civil Engineering Technology-Transportation Program, Highway Construction Inspection or Highway Surveys from the National Institute for Certification in Engineering Technologies (NICET) may be substituted for the Bachelor's degree requirement.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable.
