PURPOSE OF CLASS: In the Department of Transportation, this class is accountable for supervising a staff in the District Maintenance Office engaged in the investigation, issuance and inspection of highway encroachment permits, or a staff in the Office of Maintenance engaged in the completion of engineering reviews of major permit/traffic generator applications, encroachment agreements and property release concurrences.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

THIS PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATION IS OPEN TO ANY **CURRENT** EMPLOYEE OF THE **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION** WHO BY **APRIL 27, 2012** HAS PERMANENT STATUS IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE*, SIX MONTHS SERVICE AT THE **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**, AND THE FOLLOWING EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

GENERAL EXPERIENCE: Two years experience in a lead capacity responsible for significant roadway construction and/or maintenance reconstruction, drainage or traffic engineering projects. [Note: For State employees lead capacity will be interpreted at or above the level of Transportation District Services Agent 2 or Transportation Maintenance Planner 1.]

SUBSTITUTION ALLOWED: College training in engineering may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen semester hours equaling one half year of experience to a maximum of four years for a Bachelor's degree.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Considerable knowledge of the principles and practices of highway engineering as applied to construction, reconstruction, maintenance and survey; considerable knowledge of relevant agency policies and procedures; considerable knowledge of relevant State and Federal laws, statutes and regulations; considerable interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills; considerable ability to analyze engineering plans and specifications; supervisory ability.

APPLICATION/EXAMINATION INSTRUCTIONS: In order to be considered for admittance into this examination, you must complete all parts of the examination application (CT-HR-12) detailing how you meet the minimum experience and training requirements stated above. Make certain your application form clearly details your employment history, including job titles, dates of employment, hours worked per week and actual job duties as well as college degrees earned and current licenses and certifications. **THIS MATERIAL WILL CONSTITUTE THE EXAMINATION FOR THIS CLASS. Your examination will only be scored if you meet the minimum experience and training requirements outlined above and your completed application form is date stamped by DAS/Human Resources or postmarked by April 27, 2012. A separate application form must be submitted for each exam you are applying for.
