- Schedule:** Preference is for evenings, weekends and holidays. Incumbents must work a minimum of one 8 hour shift per two week pay period, and can work up to a maximum of two 8 hour shifts per week. THE RN PER DIEM MANDATORY TRAINING CLASS IS FROM JANUARY 8, 2016, THROUGH JANUARY 25, 2016, 8:00 AM - 3:30 PM, MONDAY - FRIDAY. ATTENDANCE FOR ALL DAYS IS **MANDATORY**. In the Correctional Managed Health Care Program, incumbents in this position work on a daily or hourly basis as a regular registered nurse, providing direct professional nursing care to a variety of inmates.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Incumbents in this class must possess knowledge of principles and practices of nursing; considerable interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills.

Examples of Duties: Incumbents in this class act as a nurse working on a per diem/hourly basis; make rounds and give direct care; take and record vital signs; carry out physicians orders regarding diet, medication, and treatment; change dressings; check and distribute narcotics; maintain availability of drugs and supplies; observe adequacy of housekeeping and maintenance services; perform first aid and alert physicians to emergency conditions; record observations of physical and physiological status and actions taken; confer with nurses and physicians on other shifts regarding condition of inmates; protect human and civil rights of inmates and staff; educate inmates and their families towards an awareness and understanding of health and illness; assess clients medical-psychosocial needs; may participate in outpatient clinics and assist in physical examinations and histories; may administer EKG and eye examinations; may participate in bathing and feeding of inmates; perform related duties as required.

General Experience: Graduation from an accredited nursing program.

Special Requirement: Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a current license or temporary permit to practice professional nursing in Connecticut. Incumbents in this class may be required to travel.

Character Requirement: In addition to the checking of references and of facts stated in the application, a thorough background investigation of each candidate will be made before persons are certified for permanent appointment.

Physical Requirement: Incumbents in this class must possess general good health and retain sufficient stamina, agility, and visual and auditory acuity necessary to perform all duties of the class; are required to pass a physical examination.

Working Conditions: Incumbents in this class may be required to lift and restrain inmates and may be exposed to disagreeable conditions, communicable and/or infectious diseases and risk of injury from assaultive and/or abusive inmates.

Note: The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable. No permanent State Employee may work in a per diem position.
