Eligibility Requirement: Candidates must be on the current DAS exam certification list for Utilities Examiner 1. Current state employees who hold permanent status in the class of Utilities Examiner 1 may apply without taking the exam. Candidates on Reemployment/SEBAC lists will be given first consideration. **Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.**

Description of Duties: Participates in design, preparation and review of annual reports of all utilities required to be filed with agency and auditing of books and records of utilities subject to regulation; participates in design and installation of new accounting systems and revision of established systems; assists in analysis, interpretation and evaluation of complex financial statements and statistical exhibits submitted by utilities in rate cases; may conduct cross examination of company witnesses on financial exhibits submitted in rate cases; may be required to evaluate propriety of proposed issue of securities by Connecticut utilities in light of current security markets and accepted utility capitalization structures; may advise on effects of changes on operating results of utilities subject to agency regulation; assists in development of specifications for computerized financial and accounting models; performs related duties as required.

Special Experience: Incumbent may be required to travel.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Considerable knowledge of accounting and auditing principles and practices specific to utility companies;
- Knowledge of and ability to apply laws and regulations pertaining to public utilities;
- Knowledge of utility accounting and/or business practices;
- Interpersonal skills;
- Oral and written communication skills;
- Considerable ability to analyze and evaluate financial statements, accounting forms and accounting methods and procedures
- Knowledge of computer and statistical analytical software.
