Duties may include but not limited to: Administers various basic types of respiratory therapy such as intermittent positive pressure breathing therapy and aerosol, sputum induction and postural drainage treatments; records treatments on patient charts; cleans, sterilizes, assembles and performs minor maintenance on therapeutic equipment; participates in resuscitative efforts; may administer more difficult types of respiratory therapy and perform diagnostic testing with appropriate training and experience; performs related duties as required.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Knowledge of equipment, procedures, techniques and terminology used in respiratory therapy; interpersonal skills; ability to safely and effectively administer routine respiratory therapy.

General Experience: Incumbents in this class must possess and maintain a license as a Respiratory Care Practitioner issued by the Connecticut Department of Public Health in accordance with the applicable Connecticut General Statutes.

Special Requirement: Candidates will be required to take a physical examination to demonstrate sufficient physical strength for efficient performance of duties.
