**Eligibility Requirement:** Candidates must have applied for and passed the Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor exam and be on the current certification list promulgated by the Department of Administrative Services for this classification. State employees currently holding the above title or those who have previously attained permanent status may apply for lateral transfer. **Applicants will not have the opportunity to take the exam prior to the above closing date to qualify for this particular vacancy.**

**Duties may include but not limited to:** working as part of a multi-disciplinary team to provide comprehensive community-based services to assist young adults in achieving their individualized vocational and/or education goals. Duties include but are not limited to: conducting timely and comprehensive vocational assessments, development of skills related to employment, establishing relationships with local employers, providing job readiness training, job coaching, job counseling and collaborating with other agencies such as BRS and educational institutions. Assess client's progress and modify vocational support interventions as needed. Provide both individual and group based interventions to teach job skills and provide support to young adults. Provide services to support career development for both short and long-term goals.

**Special Experience and Training:** Incumbents in this class must possess and retain a valid driver's license and may be required to travel.

**Note:** Applicants will be selected in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion, collective bargaining unit contract language, merit employment lists and DMHAS affirmative action goals. Therefore, State employees will generally be considered before applicants from outside State service.

**Application Instructions:** Due to the large number of lateral transfer forms and applications received, it is extremely important to note the **Position Number (found on the posting)** on the DMHAS Lateral Transfer Request Form (**upper right-hand corner**) and at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application for Examination or Employment (CT-HR-12).

**To be considered for this position:**

1. **DMHAS employees who are lateral transfer candidates** (example: Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor applying to a Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor posting) must submit a completed DMHAS Lateral Transfer Form. Lateral Transfer Request Forms received without a position number will not be processed.
2. **DMHAS employees who are promotional/demotional candidates** must submit the State of Connecticut Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). The position number must be noted at the bottom of Page One of the State of Connecticut Application (CT-HR-12).
3. **All other applicants** must complete a State Employment Application for Examination and Employment (CT-HR-12). Resumes and Curriculum Vitae can be provided as supplemental information but will only be accepted if attached to a fully completed application.
