There is an opportunity for an Engineering Intern. The target class is Design Engineer 1 (Electrical). This position is located in the Bureau of Finance & Administration, Properties & Facilities Unit. This class is accountable for receiving training in introductory professional engineering work for the development of technical and professional engineering skills and knowledge in order to qualify for advancement to the technical engineering work of the agency.

The training for this position will be specific to electrical work. A good portion of the work involves field inspection of electrical work. Experience and/or education in electrical work are a plus.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** General knowledge of basic engineering theories, principles and methods; skill in use of drafting and calculating instruments; considerable ability in performing mathematical computations, making neat and accurate drawings and preparing minor design and structural details

**General Experience:** A Bachelor's degree in EITHER civil engineering or industrial technology with a specialty in construction OR engineering.

**Special Requirement:** Appointment to this class shall be for a period of not more than two (2) years or until the promulgation of an eligible list from the first examination announced by the State Personnel Division one (1) year after date of appointment for a class for which incumbent qualifies from on-the-job training.

Applicants who do not submit all the requested documents will not be considered.
