The position is full time, 40 5 hours per week and open to eligible candidates on the DAS promulgated examination list. Interested state employees who have attained permanent status in this classification may apply for a lateral transfer.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITY:

Knowledge of proper practices and systems in relation to assigned bureau; knowledge of methods used to collect and process samples; knowledge of appropriate regulations and policies relevant to assigned area; basic knowledge of techniques used to conduct environmental investigations and inspections; interpersonal skills; oral and written communication skills; ability to read and interpret statutes, regulations and policies; investigative ability; ability to recognize effects of various types of pollution.

Preferred Knowledge: A working knowledge of underground tank systems, fuel dispensing systems, and relevant federal and state regulations; Class A or Class B level operator certification is a plus.
