**EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:**

**General Experience:**

Six (6) years of professional experience in transportation civil engineering, urban, regional or environmental planning.

**Substitutions Allowed:**

1. College training may be substituted for the General Experience on the basis of fifteen (15) semester hours equaling one-half (1/2) year of experience to a maximum of four (4) years for a Bachelor's degree.
2. A Master's degree in civil engineering, transportation, urban, regional or environmental planning may be substituted for one (1) additional year of the General Experience.
3. Three (3) years of experience as a Transportation Planning Assistant 2 or Transportation Engineer Technician may be substituted for the General Experience.

**Note:** The filling of this position will be in accordance with reemployment, SEBAC, transfer, promotion and merit employment rules, if applicable. Applicants who do not submit all the requested documents will not be considered. The candidate pool resulting from these interviews may be used to fill future Transportation Planner 1 positions in the Bureau of Public Transportation within twelve months.
